

Final Coin Description

The front of the coin incorporates the Selfridge ANGB Open House Logo over an orbital rendering of the State of Michigan, Selfridge ANGB is highlighted with a blue star, with the Moon and Mars in the background. This rendering represents the future of the Selfridge ANGB, “The Next 100 Years”. Around the coins edge is a blue band with the phrase “Team Selfridge A joint Service Community” acknowledging all the branches of service that the base houses. On the bottom of the band is phrase “The Next 100 Years”.

The back of the coin pays homage the 127th Wing of the Selfridge ANGB. The center of the coin displays the 127th Wings insignia. The blue band around the coin has the words “127th Wing” on the top and Selfridge Air National Guard Base, Michigan on the bottom, referencing the Unit and their base of operations.

The coin is polished gold, consist of 4 Pantone colors and white and 2 inches in diameter. Please note that the use of gradients in the illustrations is only to render the effect of polished gold only. Fonts used are the Trade Marked Selfridge font on the front of the coin and Palatino around the edge.

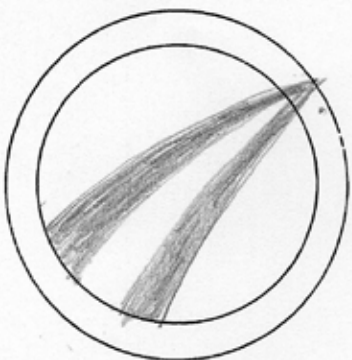
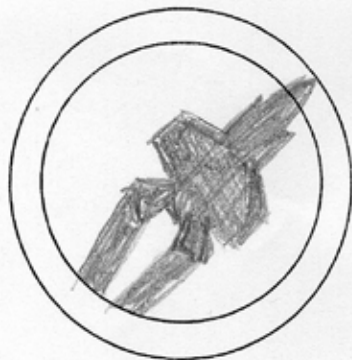
